ASC POLICY 3.9

REGISTRATION OF PART-TIME SALESMEN

- 1. This policy is issued for the benefit of persons contemplating application to the Alberta Securities Commission under section 54 of the Alberta Securities Act (the "Act") for registration as a mutual fund salesman or a scholarship plan salesman.
- 2. Regulation 41(4) under the Act states that no individual shall be granted registration as a salesman unless he is employed full time as a salesman.
- 3. For purposes of this policy, full-time employment as a salesman is required in all communities in Alberta designated as cities (and their surrounding areas). These communities are:
 - 3.1 Calgary and surrounding area (including Airdrie),
 - 3.2 Edmonton and surrounding area (including St. Albert, Spruce Grove, Sherwood Park, Stony Plain, Fort Saskatchewan), and
 - 3.3 Camrose, Drumheller, Fort McMurray, Grande Prairie, Leduc, Lethbridge, Lloydminister, Medicine Hat, Red Deer and Wetaskewin.
- 4. For purposes of this policy, an individual referred to in Regulation 41(5)(e) is deemed to include a scholarship plan salesman and, accordingly, that Regulation will be applied in accordance with item 3 of this policy.
